

EXERCISE ONE complete first innings

Object of exercise, Scorer's revision/getting up to speed with Total Cricket Scorer or Play Cricket Pro

Also ideal for helping Umpires and players understand DLS

For this challenge you can either print then record your score in the end column of the ball-by-ball sheet or load the match first 32 overs onto TCS or PlayCricket and score ball by ball to complete the challenge. I've included DLS prints as required if live game (DLS version professional 4.0 2020)

Tried something to make it more difficult by describing action the scorer sees from the score box you must interpret what you see and record what the umpire is telling you

Match Finchampstead v Banbury

Pre match discussion captains, Umpires & Scorers. 50 overs max 10 per bowler
No balls 2 runs plus free hit

Scorers drew attention the sight screen obstructed their view at one corner of the ground

Match is paused because of rain after 32 overs have been completed

Banbury batting have scored 142 runs and lost 3 wickets

Batting side not happy, wants to delay start as outfield very wet, they also feel they would lose advantage with their score already on the board should DLS come in

Now import match and score the game on PlayCricket, TCS or

Use end column note each ball and running total

OK let's make a start

After long delay, Umpires informs 30 overs lost match(15 each side) now 35 overs per side

For those using PlayCricket you must update DLS by adding those details before continuing

EXERCISE FOUR

Now the reason I mention the blind spot where the scorers could not see the action

I know it would not happen; you are all good scorers, but I like a twist at the end of a story

While working out the result C Haupt came into score box and pointed out his catch had not been recorded

Scorers informed him that they had not seen a catch he was involved with

He insisted he had taken a catch

This was confusing, the scorer asked him which catch should have been credited to him

Haupt explained it was on the last ball of the innings

Scorers explained the blind spot from the score box, agreed the ball had been hit in the air it was raining and they were unsighted as what happened next, and everybody was just running off the pitch. Batsmen completed one run and that was recorded. The Scorers agreed they would consult the umpires and if they confirmed the score would be amended.
